

Health and Safety Laws approved for the protection of Healthcare Providers'- implementation mechanism discussed between SHCC and SZABIST.

The Sindh Healthcare Service Providers and Facilities Prevention of Violence and Damage to Property Act, 2021 Sindh Act no. XVIII of 2022 and The Provincial Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Act, 2018 Sindh Act no. XXXVIII of 2018 was passed by the Sindh Provincial Assembly. Dr. Ahson Qavi Siddiqi conducted a meeting with Shahnaz Wazir Ali, President SZABIST, and her team from the Law, Health, and Media Science departments on the subject matter. The meeting was aimed to discuss the two recently passed Acts and their implementation activities. Heads of both organizations agreed to find ways of disseminating new Acts to relevant stakeholders and organizations for application. Dr. Farid Medhat, Professor of Public Health, Dr. Bilal Siddiqui lecturer of



Public Health, Ms. Ruf Chaudhary, Lecturer of Law Dept. and Syeda Mehwish Zaidi, Head of Dept Media Science from SZABIST, Dr. Altaf Khawaja, Director Licensing and Accreditation and Mr. Yaseen Veesar from SHCC attended the meeting.

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Transformation in Hospital Sector in Pakistan was agreed upon in a high-level meeting.

The Ministry of National Health Services Regulation and Coordination (NHSR&C) Government of Pakistan in collaboration with the World Health Organization organized a technical working group meeting. The meeting was conducted to formulate National and Provincial strategic plans for hospitals providing services in the public and private sectors. During the meeting, all participant from stakeholder organizations provided their respective input for developing a concise working paper/guideline for the transformation of hospital systems and its subsequent implementation.

Team Black won the SHCC Premier League


